NEVHC LAUNCHES ANNUAL TOY DRIVE AND SANTA VISITS PROGRAM BENEFITING PEDIATRIC PATIENTS

Over 2,000 children are expected to receive a donated toy at an NEVHC health center

San Fernando, CA – Northeast Valley Health Corporation (NEVHC) launched its Annual Holiday Toy Drive and Santa Visits Program benefiting over 2,000 pediatric patients in the San Fernando and Santa Clarita valleys. From December 6-15, children between the ages of newborn to ten will receive an unwrapped toy and a picture with Santa Clause at one of seven NEVHC health centers in the area. Currently in its 21st year of production, the toy giveaway is a holiday highlight for NEVHC pediatric patients and their families who reside in medically underserved communities throughout Los Angeles County and may experience financial hardship during the holiday season.

"It really feels like Christmas when Santa arrives at our health centers. Our youngest patients are so excited to receive a new toy and for our donors and staff it is such a positive experience to see their joy," said NEVHC CEO, Kimberly Wyard.

Each donated toy has been carefully selected and matched with a young patient at one of seven NEVHC health centers which offers pediatric services. The health centers included in this year's toy giveaway and Santa visits program include Sun Valley, Pacoima, Canoga Park, San Fernando, Van Nuys, Valencia, and Santa Clarita. At the giveaway at the Pacoima Health Center, NEVHC staff was joined by Anthem Blue Cross who took part in the holiday festivities by helping distribute toys, healthy snacks and meeting and their families during the event.
